 - d. Printed or digital, and submitted electronically.
 - e. Can include up to 3 images, drawings or figures
- 4. Entries can be sent from February 1 on
- 5. No entries will be accepted after March 7
- 6. Entries to be sent by email as a Word attachment to secretaryarrg@gmail.com
- 7. Judging will be by a team of three people.
- 8. Winners will be announced before the end of March
- 9. All entrants will be notified of results by email
- 10. By entering you agree that the Ashley Rakahuri Rivercare Group has the right to publish, reproduce and copy the entries. The winners' work will be on the group's official website, and may be in other publications.

11. Prizes

- a. **First prize:** weekend accommodation for a family of four at the Waikuku Beach Holiday Park, plus a guided tour of the Estuary by an ARRG representative.
